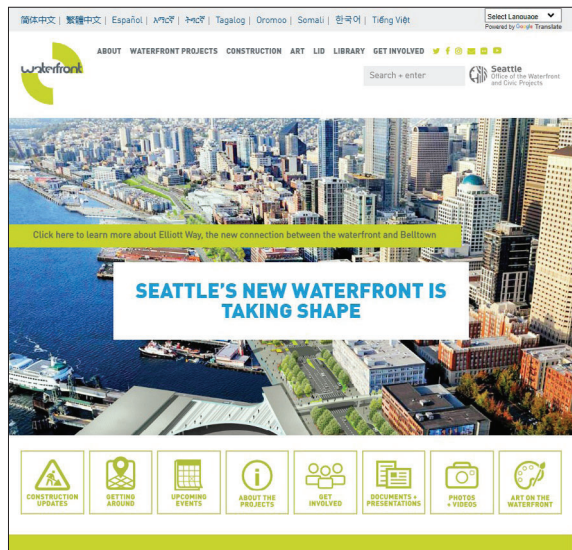

- SUPPORT:** INSTALLED 77 SOLDIER PILES AND 142 GROUND ANCHORS
- BRIDGE:** 18 GIRDERS WERE PLACED OVER THE RAILROAD TRACKS
- STRENGTH:** THERE'S MORE THAN 1 MILLION LBS OF REINFORCING STEEL INSIDE
- COMPLETE!** ABOUT 70-FOOT ELEVATION DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ALASKAN WAY AND BELL ST

- OVER 3,200 FEET OF NEW BIKE LANES:** THE EQUIVALENT OF 12 AVERAGE DOWNTOWN SEATTLE CITY BLOCKS
- 4 NEW VEHICLE LANES:** CONNECTING BELLTOWN AND THE WATERFRONT
